<p>Membership in the <i>Land of Enchantment PTA</i> is for individuals to support the work of New Mexico PTA and may not be affiliated with a local PTA.</p> <p>New Mexico PTA was established in May 1915 and over the last 100 years has successfully advocated for New Mexico's children.</p> <p>In the 1930's, NMPTA worked successfully to pass legislation requiring a driver's license and advocated for a sales tax to support schools. In the 1940's, NMPTA sponsored legislation for a school lunch program and supported resolutions for adequate teachers' salaries. Work in the 50's and 60's resulted in a nationally recognized Clothing Bank and support for resolutions urging traffic safety school zones and the establishment of kindergartens. The latter decades of the century saw NMPTA advocate for graduated driver's licenses, background checks for school and day care personnel and Arts in Education. The 2000's have seen the development of a Male Engagement program and strengthened partnerships with various stakeholders working together for New Mexico's students.</p> <p>New Mexico PTA's second 100 years brings a commitment to increase family engagement in all aspects of children's lives.
